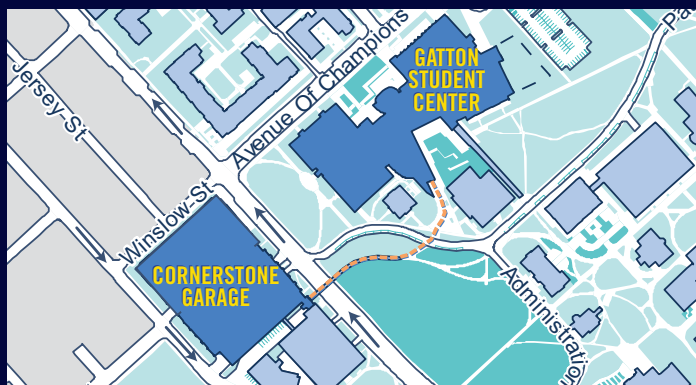


GETTING TO US

- Review our [Health and Safety Expectations on the reverse of these instructions](#).
- You may use a maps app or GPS device for directions to Cornerstone Garage, where you'll park. This is the only approved visitor parking.

- Arrive at the Visitor Center 15 minutes early to allow time for check-in. Lexington is in the **Eastern Time Zone**.

AFTER YOU'VE PARKED

- Bring the white parking slip (and your mask!) from Cornerstone Garage to the Visitor Center.
- Follow signs to the third floor pedway to campus in stairwell A.
- Cross the pedway and take the left fork.
- Enter the Gatton Student Center from the doors nearest the **large, blue UK logo**.
- The Visitor Center will be immediately on your left.



WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US:

- A 90-minute safely distanced walking tour of campus that will introduce you to the Wildcat community.
- An admission presentation sent to you ahead of your visit to watch at your convenience.
- Your campus tour guide will wear a mask throughout the entirety of your visit and will practice appropriate physical distancing.
- All University students, staff, and faculty - including members of the UK Visitor Center team - will have completed a daily self-assessed symptom check prior to their arrival on campus the day of your visit.
- Check-in will be contactless and while we will have physical admissions materials for you, they may also be shared with you electronically.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU:

- You must register for a visit with us at least 24-hours in advance.
- You may only be accompanied by two guests - a maximum of three visitors per party.
- Please bring your own mask! You and your guests will be required to wear a mask over your nose and mouth throughout the entirety of your visit.
- You must practice physical distancing from individuals not in your party.
- We recommend you complete a self-assessed symptom check the day of your visit. This information will not be recorded or received by the University.

HELPFUL TIPS AHEAD OF YOUR VISIT

A quick list of the top four things to know before your visit.

NO. 1

An admission presentation linked from your itinerary will be sent to you ahead of your visit to watch at your convenience.

NO. 2

Complete your self-assessed symptom check the day of your visit and bring your mask! The screening information will not be recorded.

NO. 3

Keep the weather in mind. We tour rain, snow or shine. Bring an umbrella if needed and wear comfortable shoes for our 2-mile walking tour.

NO. 4

If your vehicle is taller than 8'2" please call our parking office at 859-257-5757. Accessible parking is available in the Cornerstone Garage.
